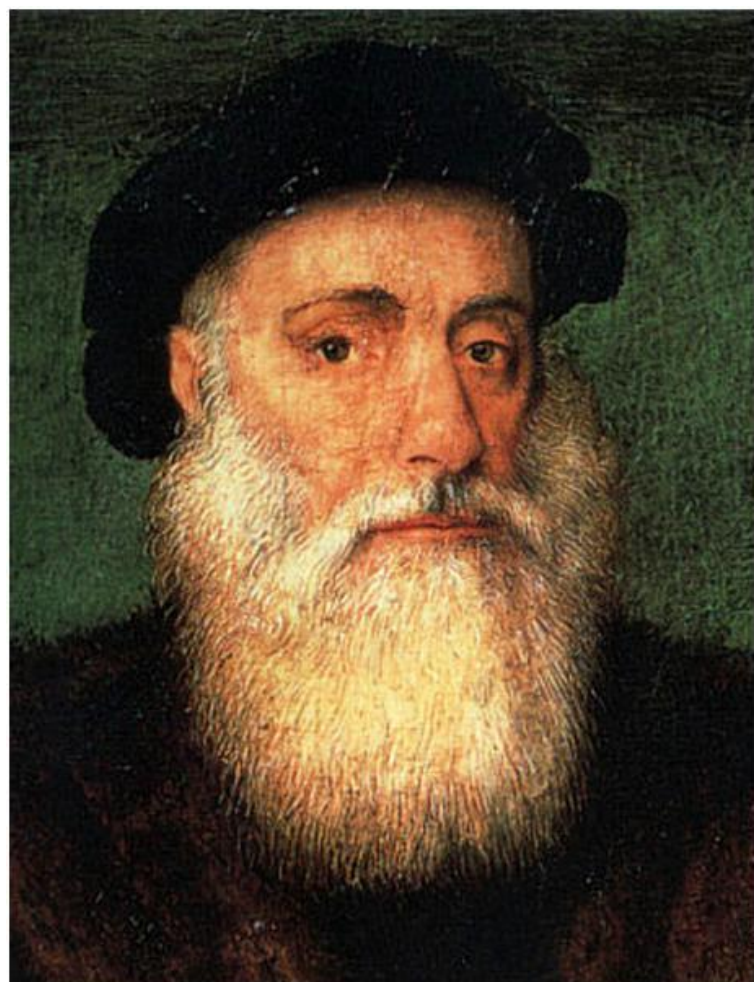


## EXHIBITION » Lisboa Story Centre

In the 15th century Lisbon is the starting point for the world's discoveries. Portugal and Spain continue their disputes but now they compete for new land, new products and people that will find during the adventure of the Discoveries which begins at the Atlantic Ocean.

In 1493 the Treaty of Tordesilhas divides the world in two and it's signed by king João II of Portugal and by the Catholic kings of Spain (Queen Isabel of Castela and king Fernando II of Aragão). Five years later Vasco da Gama sets sail from Belém (Lisboa) and discovers the maritime way to India, arriving at Calecute on May 20th 1498. Since then a new and prosperous spice route was finally discovered.

In 1499 the Portuguese navigator and explorer is distinguished by King D. Manuel and years later, in 1524, appointed Viceroy of India by King João III.

### » Lisboa Story Centre – Cosmopolitan (main floor).

Lisboa Story Centre is an exhibition dedicated to the city of Lisbon that combines both memories and technology. During 60 minutes visitors can enjoy a journey across 20 centuries of history, since its foundation until nowadays.



The visit is guided by an audio guide available in 9 languages: Portuguese (with a version for children), Spanish, English, French, Italian, German, Russian, Mandarin and Japanese.
